How to apply:

Mail or deliver the following materials to Mr. Knight by the deadline:

- 1. Completed Common Scholarship Application (CSA)
- 2. An essay or letter of intent about your education and career
- Letters of recommendation from teachers or independent third party three
 maximum
- 4. Unofficial transcript
- 5. Will need to participate in an interview
